### What is Engineers Week?

Engineers Week is a nationally recognized week, taking place every year over the third week of February. It is a week to celebrate how engineers make a difference in our world, to increase public dialogue about the need for people in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math (STEM) careers, and to bring engineering and STEM to life for students, educators, and parents.

Hanford Engineers Week is sponsored by the Hanford Engineers Week Committee, which is comprised of various Hanford contractors. There are three programs covering elementary, middle, and high school students.

WRPS coordinates the elementary-level activities in a program known as Zoom into Engineering. This program brings volunteering engineers from WRPS and other contractors to local elementary classrooms to discuss STEM and engineering and to go through a fun, hands-on activity. Volunteers are provided a PowerPoint slideshow and all the materials needed for the activity. They go through the short presentation with their class and then lead the students through the activity, which covers a key engineering concept.

#### **COVID Related**

Currently, no schools have any COVID-related requirements for volunteers to participate in E-Week. Any changes to this will be communicated to volunteers as soon as we become of aware of them.

#### **Other**

School districts may require volunteers to complete an online School District Volunteer Application form. This is a short online form that will cover a volunteer for any school in the district to which the application applies. This helps the districts manage their volunteers from their side.
